Dear Parents and Guardians,

Burlington Township High School will be operating on a special delayed opening schedule from December 10th through the 17th. We will be administering the PARCC tests to **all students enrolled in a first semester** Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, English 1, English 2, and English 3 course. Students in the Class of 2019 are required to pass the PARCC or one of the other tests listed below. Students in the Classes of 2020, 2021, and 2022 may also use one of the tests listed below, **provided that they have taken all of the required PARCC exams**. We want all of our students to be eligible to graduate on time, and therefore, taking the PARCC test is imperative. In addition, New Jersey community colleges are now using the PARCC scores as an entrance requirement.

SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing-450; SAT Math-440

ACT- 16 on Reading and Math

ACT Aspire- 422 on the reading and math

ASVAB-AFQT 31 on the reading and math

Accuplacer- Write Placer 6

Accuplacer- Math 76

PARCC- ELA 9 and 10-750, ELA 11-725; Algebra 1- 750, Algebra 2 and Geometry- 725

PSAT Reading sub-score-22; PSAT math sub-score- 22

Meet the criteria of the NJDOE Portfolio Appeal in English Language Arts and Math

The ELA PARCC exams will be given from Monday-Wednesday, Dec. 10th- 12th and the Math PARCC exams will be given Thursday, Friday, and Monday, Dec. 13th, 14th, and 17th. Only students taking those exams should report to school on time. Students not enrolled in these classes during the first semester will report to school for a 10:00am start time. Students taking the bus should report to their bus stop 2 hours and 30 minutes later than the regular time. Students who are not taking the exam will report to the following locations:

9th -- Hopkins cafeteria

10th -- Main building cafeteria

11th -- Main building cafeteria

12th -- Main building gym
